#7 Using Fairlawn model at GLA and Dexter – 3rd grade – change in 4th and 5 grade level – core instruction in reading is weak in small groups with Acuity instead of large group instruction – more specific to child based on skill they need – how is it monitored from grade to grade – using Acuity assigning instructional resources and using common assessments that will be used – student goals, and Lodge – progress monitoring every two weeks – some open response 3-8 coaches developing 10 questions. Dexter – daily five – best practices – pd on literacy at Bosse – need mandates on 3-5 & 6th? Should all BEST schools send a 5th or 6th grade teacher ?
